Pennies Floating on Blubber

Lesson 6 extension

What other advantages does blubber provide to whales and other marine mammals?

- Make sure both the blubber bag and the control bag (no filling, no air) are closed.
- · Carefully flatten out each bag.
- Float each bag on the surface of the water.
- Slowly and carefully see how many pennies you can place on top of each bag before it starts to sink. Record these numbers in the data table.
- Try this two more times and take an average of the number of pennies needed to make each bag sink.
